Local Visits and Trips Out

Local Visits and trips out are a very important part of learning in nursery, therefore we may go out of school to visit certain places. Venues will depend on the current theme, but may include trips to the local park, post office or shops.

Uniform

September – October half term/ Easter- July Summer uniform must be worn

After October half term- Easter – winter uniform must be worn

All pupils will require:

- Bottle green school coat or Summer blazer
- School tie (on elastic)
- School shoes (black or brown)
- Green wooly hat with the school badge and school scarf
- Green baseball cap with school badge for summer

In addition girls will require:

- Bottle green or tartan pinafore dress- winter uniform (the green pinafore dress is gradually being replaced with the tartan pinafore dress. The tartan pinafore dress will be compulsory from September 2017)/ Green candy striped dress – summer uniform
- White short sleeved blouse or polo shirt- winter uniform
- Bottle green cardigan with the school badge
- Green socks or tights with winter uniform and white socks or tights with summer uniform

In addition boys will require:

- Grey trousers/Grey shorts (long trousers for winter uniform, shorts for summer uniform)
- Short sleeved white shirt or white polo shirt
- Bottle green jumper with school badge
- Grey socks

Nursery children can wear a green jogging suit with the school badge, a white polo shirt with the school badge and black school shoes.

Our Class Bear

Hockney have a teddy bear one called Spencer; the bear will be sent home each week with a different child or maybe over the school holidays. Spencer has a diary he keeps to remind him of the things he has done over the weekend with his class friend, don't worry if you're not going anywhere over the weekend when the bear comes home with your child. Sometimes after a long week at school he is tired and just likes to play at home. In his diary he likes to put photographs/or a drawing of what he has been doing. He also likes to put short descriptions of the things he has done. This is to help encourage and develop your child's language.

During circle time we will encourage your child to talk about what they have been doing as a show and tell session. This will not only help your child's language development but will help build their confidence in group situations.

Each week the children will be able to choose a book from the library box to take home. These books are to be returned the following week. We would be grateful if you could help and encourage your child to take care of the books they bring home. We hope you enjoy sharing the books with your child.
