This week it is National Anti-Bullying Week in Schools. The children will experience a series of different assemblies and class-based activities in which we discuss what bullying is, how we can prevent this from occurring in school, the damage caused by bullying and what children should do if they discover that bullying is taking place. There are posters around school which explain to the children that bullying is when rude or mean behaviour occurs on several occasions, rather than as a one-off incident. All children will be taking home a document titled 'Anti-bullying Information for Parents' today, which will provide you with additional information on this sensitive subject.
