



Rewards for good behaviour

Our children continue to earn merits if they impress their teacher in school. These may be awarded for a variety of reasons. Examples include putting lots of effort into their work, persevering when something is challenging, or for excellent conduct around the school. When children have achieved **5 merits** they will receive a **bronze badge/certificate**; when they have achieved **8 merits** they will receive a **silver badge/certificate**; when they have achieved **10 merits** they will receive a **gold badge/certificate**.



We have four school houses. Every child from Reception to Year 6 has been placed into a house. The houses are Webb (Red), Nelson (Green), Ball (Blue) and Midgley (Yellow.) Children earn points for their House when they achieve a Bronze/Silver/Gold certificate. House points can also be earned through extra-curricular achievements, such as a sport or music award. I will use the newsletter to keep you updated on the total number of points that each house has earned.
