

Breakfast Club – Changes to prices and timings

We are getting increasing numbers of children arriving before 8:00am for Breakfast Club, even though 8:00am has been the official start time for some time. **We have therefore changed the opening time of Breakfast Club to 7:45am. Any children who are dropped off at Breakfast Club before 8:00am will be charged £2.** Any children who are dropped off between 8:00am and 8:30am will be charged £1 as normal. This new opening time and pricing policy comes into effect from tomorrow (Tuesday 6th December.)

When children are dropped off it is important that they are accompanied up to our front door. We do not allow parents to stay in the car and leave children to walk up to the front door unaccompanied.
