



Rewards for good behaviour

Our children continue to earn merits if they impress their teacher in school. These may be awarded for a variety of reasons. Examples include putting lots of effort into their work, or persevering when something is challenging, or for excellent conduct around the school. When children have achieved **5 merits** they will receive a **bronze badge/certificate**; when they have achieved **8 merits** they will receive a **silver badge/certificate**; when they have achieved **10 merits** they will receive a **gold badge/certificate**.



We have new names for our four school houses. Every child from Reception to Year 6 has been placed in a house. The houses are Webb, Nelson, Ball and Midgley. These names are in honour of the four most recent owners of Netherleigh and Rossefield School, as we believe it is important for the children to have respect for the school's history. Children will earn 'medal points' for their House when they achieve a Bronze/Silver/Gold certificate. Medal points can also be earned through extra-curricular achievements, such as a sport or music award.



Money has still been arriving in to school in support of our Harvest appeal for the Send a Cow project. We are therefore unable to give you the exact final figure raised. Prizes were given out in last Friday's assembly to the class who raised the most money, and to classes where every pupil returned their collection pot. 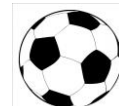
